

1.1. OTRANTO, BALCONY OF THE EAST (BICYCLE EXCURSION)

DEPARTURE: Porta Terra, Otranto – DURATION: full day

TRAVEL DISTANCE: approximately 35 km – DIFFICULTY: average/easy

ITINERARY:

The inland of Otranto is probably the best preserved area of Salento. Going up the Idro Valley, we visit an ancient **Byzantine crypt**, and then stop at the Constantine Foundation where they practise the art of **traditional weaving**. We then cross the 'megalithic garden' of Giurdignano, dotted with dolmen and menhir.

Tasting lunch at one of the best bakeries of the province, in Specchia Gallone. After lunch we reach Porto Badisco, with its calm, sheltered beach. After a swimming (if weather allows) we return to Otranto, along one of the most beautiful stretches of the coast, visiting the lighthouse of Punta Palascìa (eastern most point in Italy) and the stunning Bauxite Lake.

1.2. OTRANTO BALCONY OF THE EAST (HIKING)

DEPARTURE POINT: Otranto's castle – DURATION: full day

TRAVEL DISTANCE: 20 km – DIFFICULTY: average

ITINERARY:

Departing from the Castle of Otranto we head towards the harbour along the coastal area, reaching the **Snake's tower**. This is the starting point of a coastal path leading to **Punta Palascia lighthouse**, the easternmost point of Italy and geographical boundary between the Ionian Sea and the Adriatic.

After a **cheese tasting** in a local farmhouse, we visit the ruins of the **Church of San Nicola di Casole** and magnificent **Bauxite Lake**, whose bold colors have created a unique landscape.



2. CIPOLLIANE TREK IN LEUCA (HIKING)

- DEPARTURE POINT: Ciolo Bridge, Gagliano del Capo DURATION: half day (3h)
- TRAVEL DISTANCE: 9 km DIFFICULTY: Easy

ITINERARY:

The hike starts from the **Ciolo bridge** going through a caynon along a beautiful path that unfolds between **'pajare'**, **dry stone walls** and a varied flora including the so-called 'trans-Balkanic' plants.

Then we follow a second path which extends parallel to the coast, surrounded by **stone walls, terraces and 'mantagnate'** (cyclopean works erected by man to protect small fields).

We reach then the **Cipolliane caves**, where you can see stalactites and columns, tunnels and fossils, 'waterfalls' of caper plants and colonies of birds that have made their home there.

Heading back to our departure point, we have the chance for a break at the beach.

3. CYCLING TO THE END OF THE WORLD: LEUCA

- DEPARTURE POINT: Torre di Salignano DURATION: half day
- TRAVEL DISTANCE: approximately 15 km DIFFICULTY: easy

ITINERARY:

The Cape of Leuca, once considered '**De Finibus Terrae'** (the end of the world), is an area made up of tiny and evocative villages and farms. Cycling through the weaving countryside roads that link these villages full of history and charm, we discover some of the hidden treasures, like the **Defense Tower of Salignano**, the enigmatic **Centopietre** in Patù, the **Medieval Castle** in Giuliano and the **Sanctuary of Leuca Piccola** in Barbarano. We complete the excursion with a great tasting of local products in the ancient inn 'Retro'.
